5 Pro-Active Strategies for Positive Behavior Management

Have systems to respond to behavior. Acknowledge positive behavior when you see it. Research suggests making five positive comments for every correction. Provide rewards (when appropriate) for demonstrating positive behavior. Collect data to look at the causes of inappropriate behavior.
