The Hague Conventions of 1899 and 1907 are a series of international treaties and declarations negotiated at two international peace conferences at The Hague in the Netherlands. Along with the Geneva Conventions, the Hague Conventions were among the first formal statements of the laws of war and war crimes in the body of secular international law. A third conference was planned for 1914 and later rescheduled for 1915, but it did not take place due to the start of World War I.

The Second Peace Conference was held in 1907 to expand upon the original Hague Convention, modifying some parts and adding others, with an increased focus on naval warfare. This was signed in October 1907 and entered into force in 1910. Peace Palace. The Third Hague Peace Conference, planned for 1915, was usurped by the First World War, but 4 years of trench warfare did their work and the Conference's ideals were institutionalised in a Permanent Meeting of the League of Nations in Switzerland.

The Hague - First and Second Peace Conferences

Hague Peace Conferences (1899, 1907) were the largest diplomatic conferences between the Congress of Vienna and the outbreak of World War I. Czar Nicholas II of Russia, calling for limitation of armaments, proposed the first conference (1899) at the Dutch seat of government. Representatives of twenty-six governments attended.

The conference took place in The Hague between 18 May and 29 July 1899 and was attended by twenty-six delegations. The conference was successful in its work on international humanitarian law and the law on the pacific settlement of disputes, notably with establishment of the Permanent Court of Arbitration, but it failed to achieve a reduction of military budgets and a plan for disarmament.

These efforts, which began in the mid-nineteenth century, peaked with the 1899 and 1907 Hague Peace Conferences. Participating delegates adopted numerous binding instruments covering various aspects of peaceful dispute settlement and - war fighting.
